John Scott was born in Wakefield, England, received his earliest musical training as a chorister at Wakefield Cathedral, and gained the diplomas of the Royal College of Organists, winning the major prizes, while still in school. He was Organ Scholar of St. John's College, Cambridge, where he studied with Dame Gillian Weir and made his Royal Albert Hall debut as the youngest organ soloist to appear in the "Proms". He subsequently became Assistant Organist at both St. Paul's and Southwark Cathedrals in London, later becoming Sub-Organist of St. Paul's, and then Organist and Director of Music there in 1990. He has recordings on the Guild, Hyperion, Nimbus and Priory labels, including the organ music of Dupré, Duruflé, Elgar, Mathias and Mendelssohn.
